

## **ORDER**

In view of the prevailing situation arising out due to outbreak of novel coronavirus (COVID-19), the Chandigarh Administration has passed the order dated 22.03.2020 which has been conveyed vide endorsement no.F-2071/F-II(6)-2020/5000 regarding lockdown in the territory of Union Territory, Chandigarh, from 23.3.2020 to 31.3.2020.

Keeping in view the grave situation and emergency Conference Call meeting held between the President and Members of the State Commission and also District Forums-1 and II, U.T., Chandigarh, it has been resolved as under:-

1. All the urgent/fresh cases listed for 23.03.2020 before this State Commission as well as the District Forums-1 and II, U.T., Chandigarh, if not already adjourned, shall be adjourned by the NIC to 24.04.2020.
2. The other urgent/fresh cases, if, fixed for any other date after 23.03.2020, before this State Commission as well as District Forums-1 and II, U.T., Chandigarh, shall be adjourned by the NIC to 27.04.2020.
3. During this period, no ordinary filing shall be entertained. If the limitation of any case expires during this period, the benefit of this period shall be extended on the same pattern as during the regular vacations.
4. The working of this State Commission as well as District Forums-1 and II, U.T., Chandigarh, during 23.3.2020 to 31.3.2020 shall be restricted only to the cases of utmost urgency, such as arrest of a person etc. only on mentioning between 10.30 am to 11.30am on each day i.e. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday before the Secretary of this Commission (Sh.Rakesh Singh Rawat)-Mobile No.09988871967/email Id:-stcomm-chd@nic.in.and Thursday and Friday before the Private Secretary of this Commission (Sh.Jaspal Singh)-Mobile No.09417936966/email Id:-stcomm-chd@nic.in., who shall obtain necessary orders from the President of this Commission as well as the District Forums-I and II, U.T. Chandigarh, as the case may be. The mentioning will be made only on mobile phones of the above said Officer(s) or through email ID as aforementioned, which will be restricted to urgent filing only.
5. The Presidents and Members of this State Commission as well as the District Forums-1 and II, U.T., Chandigarh, may work from home, except when their presence is required to handle the utmost urgent matters or for any other reason.

1. All the necessary account works shall continue in this State Commission as well as District Forums-1 and II, U.T., Chandigarh, from 23.3.2020 to 31.3.2020.
