FILING

1.	<p>Before filing any kind of complaints, appeals, revision petitions, execution applications, miscellaneous applications etc. etc., the Advocates/litigants shall supply softcopy of the documents i.e. entire paper book preferably through pen drive/CD or through email to this Commission/District Forum-I & II i.e. stcomm-chd@nic.in (scanned documents in PDF form). If there shall be any difference between hardcopy and the softcopy, then, hardcopy shall be treated as authenticated document.</p> <p>The hard copies of the same be placed in filing Petition Box, lying at the entry gate of the building of State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, U.T., Chandigarh which shall be locked. Each day, it will be opened at 4:00 P.M. The petitions i.e. complaints, appeals, revision petitions, execution applications, miscellaneous applications etc. etc. shall be registered on the same day, which should be kept separately for 2 days thereafter, so that there may not be any chance of any kind of infection thereon.</p>
2.	<p>No person shall be allowed to enter the building of this Commission without wearing MASK. They shall also maintain SOCIAL DISTANCING as per Government Norms.</p>

FILING OF URGENT MATTERS:

3.	<p>All urgent petitions i.e. complaints, appeals, revision petitions, execution applications, miscellaneous applications etc. etc. shall be filed in the registry alongwith softcopy preferably through pen drive/CD or through email to this Commission/District Forum-I & II i.e. stcomm-chd@nic.in (scanned documents in PDF form) during the lockdown period with prior information to the Secretary of the Commission at his mobile no. 9988871967.</p> <p>After the lockdown period, such matters depending upon the urgency of the case, shall be shown in the cause list 2 days thereafter.</p>
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ARGUMENTS/CONSIDERATION THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCING:

4.	<p>Till the regular infrastructure is set up for video conferencing, arguments/consideration in the matters shall be done by way of <u>Video Conferencing</u> available with this Commission and District Forum - I and II. While addressing arguments through video conferencing, Advocates/Litigants are advised to wear proper dress.</p>
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
